

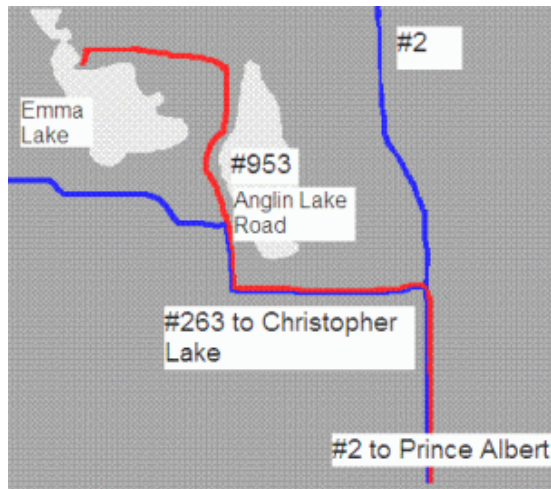
Who We Are

In 2012 we hosted our Fiftieth Anniversary regatta.

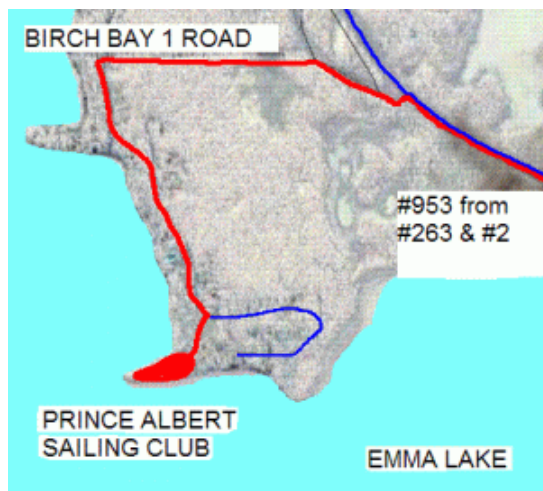
Location

Emma Lake at Birch Bay 1. We are located just below the Middle Lake on Birch Bay Point – on the east side of the lake, across the bay from McIntosh Point.
